



Ela Township Homework Club

a K-5th grade after school program for residents of Ela Township

LOCATION: Community Center (380 Surryse Rd. Lake Zurich)

Ages: Kindergarten - 5th grade

Days & Times: After school everyday district 95 is in session until 5:00 PM

COST: \$10 per month per child

Registration

Registration is open throughout the school year and will be processed on a first come first serve basis. Any participants that register for a month that has already been filled will be added to a wait list and contacted if space becomes available.

Registration begins on Monday, July 16th.

Completed packets along with payment can be dropped off at the Community Center.

General Information about Homework Club

Registration & Attendance:

Homework Club begins on Wednesday, August 22nd, 2018 and runs throughout the school year ending on Monday, June 3rd, 2019. Participants register by month at a cost of \$10 per month per child. There is no minimum number of months required to register and you do not have to register for consecutive months.

Registration reserves a spot for your child(ren) every day of that month. Exact dates covered by each month are listed below. Daily attendance is optional, and no notification is required for any days your child will be absent. However, there are no refunds or pro-rated fees for any days your child does not attend the program.

Dates:

Aug/Sept: Aug 22 - Sept 21 (22 Days)

October: Sept 24 - Oct 19 (18 Days)

November: Oct 22 - Nov 20 (20 Days)

December: Nov 26 - Dec 21 (20 Days)

January: Jan 7 - Feb 1 (18 Days)

February: Feb 4 - Mar 1 (18 Days)

March: Mar 4 - Apr 5 (20 Days)

April: Apr 8 - May 3 (20 Days)

May: May 6 - June 3 (19 Days)

Drop Off & Pick Up Procedures:

The front parking lot should be used for both drop off and pick up. Participants can enter and exit through the main entrance at the front of the building. Parents are not required to come into the building during drop off. Children can be dropped off at the main entrance and walk inside to the staff table themselves to be checked in. Parents are welcome to walk in with their children to help get them situated or to communicate any specific needs for that day to the staff. During pick up parents are required to enter the building in order to sign their child out.

Sign In & Snack Time

Because we have students attending from 6 different elementary schools arrival is typically staggered and lasts until about 3:30 pm. An afternoon snack is provided daily and is usually available upon arrival. This gives everyone a chance to eat snack, hangout and talk with their friends before starting on homework.

Homework/Academic Time

During this time participants will be able to work on homework, read, study, or work on specific academic skills in a quiet environment. Staff and/or volunteers will be available to provide assistance if needed. When participants are finished with their academic work they are free to move on to recreation time.

What amount of academic work each participant is required to complete before moving on to recreation time is determined by their parent/guardian. Daily workload varies depending on age, grade, teacher, academic ability and much more. Parents are encouraged to communicate with staff what they expect their child(ren) to be working on during academic time.

Staff:

All Homework Club staff have been subject to a background check, are CPR/AED/First Aid Certified, and have had prior experience working in child care. In addition, every staff member goes through 10+ hours of training aimed at making Homework Club the safest and most enjoyable experience possible for everyone. The program is staffed at a child/staff ratio no greater than 8:1.

Volunteers:

We work closely with the National Honor Society (NHS) and Interact Club at Lake Zurich High School to provide volunteer opportunities for their members. Throughout the year LZHS Students will come to Homework Club and provide academic help to anyone who needs it.

Behavior Expectations:

The following behavior expectations are in effect at all events sponsored by Ela Township Youth Program. Individual staff and programs may develop more specific rules for youth.

- Discipline is a shared responsibility: students and adults are both responsible for an orderly, safe and equitable learning environment.
- Actions are what we have chosen to do; actions are a product of choices.
- High expectations and courteous, respectful behavior, on the part of all.
- Foster a climate of achievement.

The same behavior expectations apply to all Ela Township Youth Programs as they apply in the Lake Zurich District 95 School Policy Handbook.

Dismissal:

Inappropriate behavior may result in your child(ren) suspension or withdrawal from the program. To ensure the safety and security of all children, if an emergency occurs that threatens the welfare of a child(ren), Ela Township Staff will contact a Parent/Guardians as needed. In the event, a child’s behavior is disruptive, but does not require suspension or withdrawal of the program, the Youth Director will contact the parents and require that the child be supervised by a Parent/Guardian or older sibling at all Ela Youth Programs.
