



Ela Township Teen Club at the Foglia YMCA

a 6-8th grade after school program for residents of Ela Township

LOCATION: Foglia YMCA (1025 N. Old McHenry Rd. Lake Zurich, IL 60047)

Ages: 6th-8th Grade

Days & Times: After school everyday district 95 is in session until 6:30 PM

COST: \$50 for the school year

Overview

In partnership with the Foglia YMCA, the Teen Club program runs from 2:30-6:30 everyday District 95 schools are in session. Participants are transported from St. Francis, Middle School North, or Middle School South to the Foglia YMCA via District 95 busses. While at the YMCA participants will primarily be in the teen room where they can work on homework, use computers, play video games, or just hang out with friends. Access to the gym and other amenities is also available as long as there are no YMCA programs using that space.

All students in Ela Township who are in 6-8th grade for the 2018-2019 school year are eligible to register for the program. Students must be registered prior to attending the program. To register, fill out this packet and and turn it in at the Ela Township Community Center along with the \$50 registration fee.

Registration is ongoing throughout the school year.

Completed packets along with payment can dropped off at the Community Center.

We are currently accepting cash or check. Please make checks out to 'Ela Township'.

General Information about Teen Club

Transportation

Participants are bussed to the YMCA after school on District 95 busses. At the time of registration you will receive a bus pass for your child(ren). Participants will need to have this pass in order to be able to get on the bus after school. See below for more details regarding bus departure times at each school.

Bus numbers will be emailed to all participants once District 95 finalizes them. Usually the week before school starts. All details regarding bussing will also be available at elatownship.org.

St. Francis de Sales

- Bus leaves around 2:15 and will travel to Middle School North to make a pick up before going to the Foglia YMCA.

Middle School North

- First bus leaves after 2:20 dismissal on the north side of the school.
- Late bus leaves at 3:35 from the north side of the school until March. After March this bus will start leaving from the athletic entrance.
- Second late bus leaves at 4:15.

Middle School South

- First bus leaves after 2:20 dismissal.
- No late bus available from South.

Check In

Upon arriving at the YMCA, participants will go directly to the teen room to be signed in, get a snack, and hear any announcements staff may have that day. After getting signed in they can hang out in the teen room, work on homework, or go to the gym. After 4:00 participants can use the computers and xbox in the teen room. Prior to 4:00 everyone is encouraged to work on homework and staff is available to help if needed.

Pick Up Procedures:

To the right of the main entrance, on the outside of the building there is a set of stairs. At the bottom of those stairs is the entrance to the teen room. Parents are encouraged to use this entrance for pick up if possible. When using the main entrances to the building parents will be required to scan in with their YMCA membership or sign in as a non-member. Participants are required to be picked up no later than 6:30.

Staff:

All Teen Club staff have been subject to a background check, are CPR/AED/First Aid Certified, and have had prior experience working in child care. In addition every staff member goes through 10+ hours of training aimed at making Teen Club the safest and most enjoyable experience possible for everyone. The program is staffed at a child/staff ratio no greater than 15:1.

Dismissal:

To ensure the safety and security of all children, if an emergency occurs that threatens the welfare of a child(ren), Ela Township Staff will contact a Parent/Guardians as needed. In the event, a child's behavior is disruptive, but does not require suspension or withdrawal of the program, the Youth Director will contact the parents and require that the child be supervised by a Parent/Guardian or older sibling at all Ela Youth Programs.
